Every three to four lots during the auction a firearm will be sold.

Many of the firearms offered are 50 to 100 years old or more. Prior to firing any of these weapons they should be evaluated by a qualified gunsmith for operational safety and confirm the accuracy of the caliber. In most cases our listing of a caliber was based on notes found with the estate guns.

All regulations surrounding firearm sales will be strictly adhered to without exception
